**New Base Chapel** 

**IMCOM Soto Cano Air Base, Honduras** 

HCS was selected as the Prime A/E for the new Chapel at Soto Cano Air Base, Honduras. The facility will be the focal point of the base, being the most progressive in appearance to all facilities on this semi-permanent base installation.

The IMCOM Chapel at Soto Cano Air Base will provide a multi-denominational worship center that includes seating for 75 persons with overflow capability for 100 persons, and a multiuse fellowship hall with the flexibility to accommodate banquets and entertainment functions. Public support areas include flexible multipurpose rooms for classroom and small group worship functions, a confessional, an ablution room, and kitchen/pantry. Administrative areas include a chaplain's suite with reception and two offices, a conference room, an office for two chaplain assistants, a sacristy, office supply storage and a depository for donations. State of the art LED direct and indirect lighting systems and controls are utilized to enhance the worship experience.
